Local recreational facilities in Rocky Mountain House include 2 skating arenas, a public library, bowling alley, stampede grounds, tennis courts, cross-country skiing areas, 5 summer camps, a gun range, archery range, curling rink, an 18-hole golf course, a 400 meter outdoor oval ice surface, baseball diamonds, fish ponds and a trout ranch, and a 25 meter indoor swimming pool with all the fixings.

World-class skiing can be found three hour's drive away in Banff. Other available activities include canoeing, karate, mountain biking, hockey, curling, rodeo, soccer, bowling, and lots more. There is no shortage of things to do in Rocky Mountain House.
