Location

Situated in the southwest corner of the Province of Manitoba, the city is very close to the geographical centre of North America (situated north of Rugby, North Dakota). It is located 197 km (130 miles) west of Winnipeg, 365 km (225 miles) east of Regina and 100 km (60 miles) north of the United States Border. Brandon covers an area of 75km2 (47 mile2) and had an average elevation of 390 metres (1,280 feet) in the city and 409 metres (1,342 feet) at the Brandon Airport.
