Port Alberni is an affordable waterfront community at the heart of the west coast of Vancouver Island. It is situated at the end of a 48 kilometer-long inlet and offers access to amazing wilderness.

The City of Port Alberni offers a deep sea port, beautiful waterfront quays,

an airport, a new hospital, shopping mall, casino, and a well-developed array of recreational facilities and a vast supporting infrastructure often found in larger cities. In 2011, the population of Port Alberni was 25,465.

Port Alberni is close to many of Vancouver Island's premier tourist attractions including Tofino and Pacific Rim National Park. The area is known for excellent fishing. Its waters



contain five different species of salmon and yearly runs of steelhead trout. Halibut can also be found in the saltwater inlets near the city. Port Alberni also has some of the best hiking and mountain biking on Vancouver Island, with over 100 trails in and around the Alberni Valley.



Weather

Port Alberni enjoys a mild west coast climate. It is rarely too hot or too cold. Pack a raincoat though. It rains a lot.

The main highway to Port Alberni is Highway 4, which starts in Parksville and ends in Tofino. The section between Parksville and Port Alberni is known as the *Alberni Highway* and the section between Port Alberni and Tofino is known as the *Pacific Rim Highway*.

Port Alberni is a world-class destination for fishing and hiking. The city is also within three hours driving distance to top-quality beaches (Tofino), mountain biking (Parksville), and Skiing (Mt. Washington).

Besides being a hub for outdoor activity on Vancouver Island, Port Alberni is also home to museums, recreation centres, a movie theatre, and a variety of bars and restaurants.

Industry

The primary driver of Port Alberni's economy is the forest industry, although it has shrank in recent years due to pine beetle infestation, a slow U.S. housing market, and other factors. The city has promoted tourism in order to supplement the shrinking forest industry; taking advantage of its amazing wilderness and close proximity to Victoria and Vancouver.
