
# Radium, British Columbia

The closest airport is the <u>Canadian Rockies International Airport (YXC)</u>. It is located in Cranbrook, a 1.5 hour drive from Radium, and serves flights to and from Vancouver and Calgary.

The closest international airport is the <u>Calgary International Airport (YYC)</u> which serves flights to and from locations all across North America. It is a 3 hour drive from Radium to the airport.
