



Education

There are four elementary schools (K-6), one middle school (7-9), and two high schools (10-12) in Weyburn. For more information, visit <u>South East</u> Conerstone.

The closest post-secondary school to Weyburn is <u>Southeast Regional College</u> which is located in Assiniboia (an hour and 45 minutes drive), with some courses offered right in the city of Weyburn. A number of courses can be completed online through distance learning; course range from basic upgrading, business and reception diplomas, to various trades programs including hairstyling, continuing care assistant training, and electrician and power engineer technician training.

The main industries that serve Weyburn is oil, agriculture, and manufacturing. Weyburn is fully serviced with the elements of modern infrastructure. Affordable electricity through SaskPower, inexpensive natural gas through SaskEnergy, and one of the world's most extensive fibre-optic based telecommunications systems through SaskTel, featuring full digital switching. Local water supply is amply provided from a major river reservoir, and Weyburn's superior water system now services a large surrounding rural area. The sewage system is modern and upgraded to secondary treatment level.
