Transportation

Air

There are two airports near Coleville; one is the Kindersley Regional Airport that is about a 21 minute drive (27.4 km) from the city center. Kindersley Regional Airport is a busy airport used by regular charter aircraft flying customers in to meetings, courier services, Medi-vacs, flight training, and aerial spray operations. There are also a large number of recreational pilots who utilize the Kindersley Regional Airport as a fuel stop.

The second one is the Kerrobert Airport that is about 24 minute drive (31.2 km) from Coleville.

The closest International Airport to Coleville is <u>Saskatoon International Airport</u> (YXE) which has flights going across Canada and to many international destinations. This airport is located 233 km (2.5 hour drive) from Coleville's city centre.

Ground

A bus depot, Taxi and Car Rental are available in Kindersley, SK.

Accommodation

Education

<u>Roseville School</u> provides education from Kindergarten to Grade 7. <u>Kindersley Composite School</u> provides secondary education for kids in grades 8-12 out of Kindersley, SK; about 20 minutes away from Colville.

<u>Great Plains College</u>, located in Kindersley offers 18 certificate, diploma, and degree programs that help students gain real-world experience through practicum or work placements before graduation.

Health Services

The Coleville Fire Department is on the Main Street and is operated by local volunteer firemen. Coleville also has a volunteer group of First Responders.

Industry

Coleville Recreation Association was started on March 30, 1960. Recreation is in charge for the operation of the curling rink, skating rink, and the golf course/Laing's Park.
