October: 10.8° C



Location

Powell River is located north of Vancouver on British Columbia's Sunshine Coast. Although the City of Powell River is on a peninsula, the surrounding mountainous terrain makes it so a ferry ride is required to travel just about anywhere. For an online map of Powell River, [click here](#).

Nanaimo.....	150km (approx. 3.5 hours including ferry)
Vancouver	174km (approx. 4.5 hours including ferry)
Squamish.....	201km (approx. 5 hours including ferry)

Transportation

Road Access

There is no highway connecting Powell River to other mainland cities due to the impenetrable surrounding mountains. One must travel through [BC Ferries](#) if they wish to drive to any other city.

Airport

Powell River Airport (YPW) serves flights to and from Vancouver. The airport is located four minutes' drive east from the center of town.

Amenities

Powell River has many of the amenities that you might expect from a larger city. These include art galleries, museums, recreation centres, golf courses, shopping malls, specialty shops galore, a movie theatre, a skateboard park, an arena with BCHL Hockey Team (Powell River Kings), and a variety of bars and restaurants.

Powell River is a hub for outdoor adventurers. Close-by activities include mountain climbing, kayaking, canoeing, salmon and trout fishing, scuba diving, camping, and sailing to name a few.

Industry

Powell River's primary industries are forestry, tourism, fishing, and mining. Paper manufacturing and limestone quarrying are the two largest sources of jobs in Powell River. The city has traditionally been extremely reliant on its paper mill but has diversified its economy in recent years with more emphasis on other areas such as tourism and aquaculture.
