Weather

Temperature

The average high in January is -9.4 degrees Celsius; the average low is -20.1 degrees C. The spring is a short transitional season, with an average temperature of between 11.5 to -1.6 degrees Celsius. The summer is usually warm ranging from 26.5 to 12.5 degrees Celsius. Autumn is similar to spring, being warm in September and cooler in October and November.

Precipitation

Estevan sees the most rain in June, with June and February being its driest months. In the winter, there is typically some snow on the ground from the end of October to the end of April. The yearly mean average snowfall is 115 cm.

Air


