

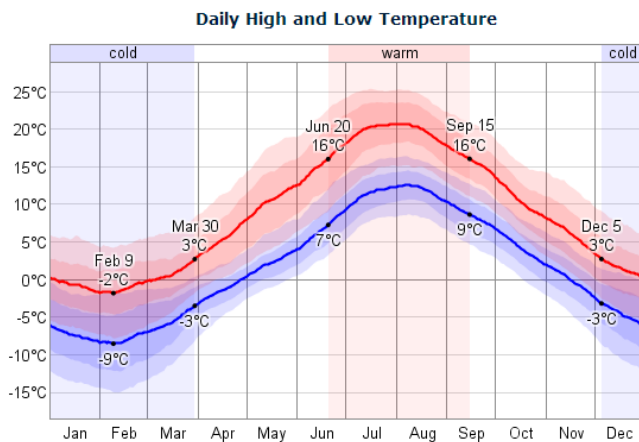

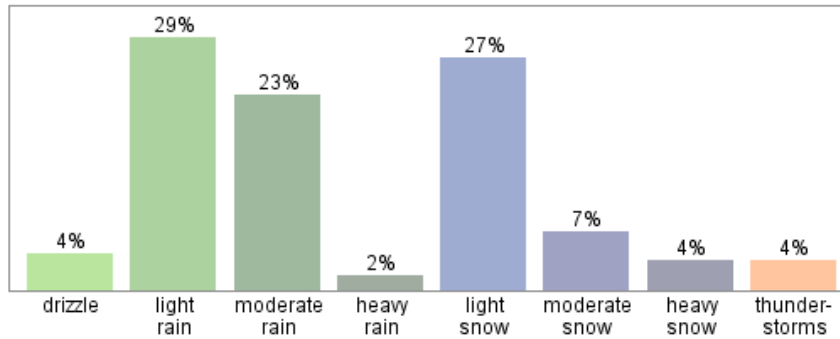

Types of Precipitation Throughout the Year

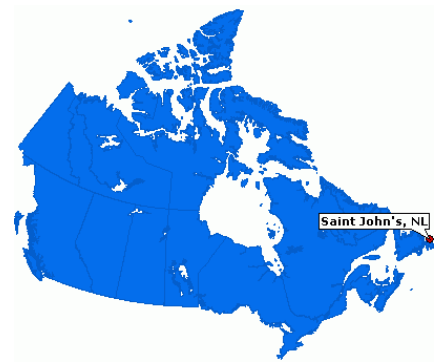


Location

St. John's is located along the coast of the Atlantic Ocean, on the northeast of the Avalon Peninsula in southeast Newfoundland.

The closest major airport to St. John's, Canada is St. John's International Airport (YYT) which has both international and domestic flights. This airport is in Saint Johns, Canada and is about 7 km from the center of St. John's, Canada.

St. John's is served by the [Eastern School District](#), the largest school district in Newfoundland and Labrador by student population. There are currently 36 primary, elementary and secondary schools in the city of St. John's, including three private schools.

Atlantic Canada's largest university, [Memorial University of Newfoundland](#) (MUN), is located in St. John's. MUN provides comprehensive education and grants degrees in several fields and its historical strengths in engineering, business, geology, and medicine, make MUN one of the top comprehensive universities in Canada.

[The Fisheries and Marine Institute of Memorial University](#) of Newfoundland (MI) or simply Marine Institute, is a post-secondary ocean and marine polytechnic located in St. John's and is affiliated with Memorial University of Newfoundland.

Taxes

Newfoundland uses HST – Harmonized Sales Tax. The general HST rate is 13% of which 5% is the GST and 8% is the provincial component of the tax. The HST is administered by Canada Revenue Agency.
