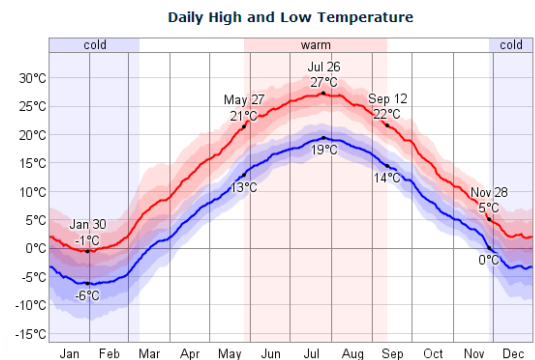

Barrie has a humid continental climate with humid, warm summers and cold winters. The average temperature in Barrie ranges from -5°C in the winter to 27°C in the summer. The warm season lasts from May to September, the cold season from late November to March. During the

Industry

Barrie is one of Canada's fastest growing cities. When the city started to grow, it began to export local resources. Trees were logged and shipped out, serving as masts for British ships, and railway ties. In the winter months, huge blocks of ice were cut from the frozen waters and shipped down to Toronto, Buffalo and New York for refrigeration purposes. Some of Barrie's major industries of employment are construction, professional, trade, technical and retail trade.

Winter season can also be fun for skiing and snowboarding and enjoy the powder-perfect alpine and nordic conditions.



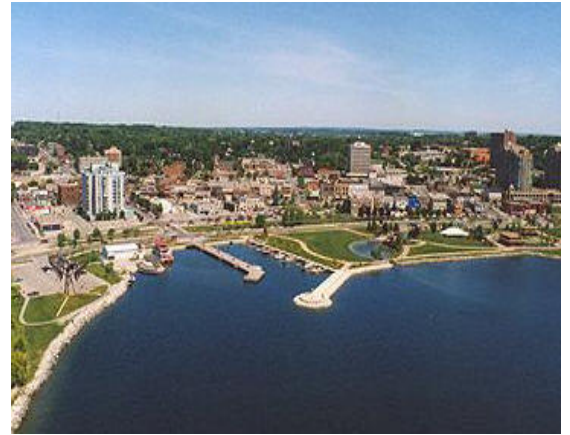

Taxes

- 5.05% on the first \$40,120 of taxable income, +
- 9.15% on the portion of taxable income more than \$40,120 but not more than \$80,242, +
- 11.16% on the portion of taxable income more than \$80,242 but not more than \$150,000, +
- 12.16% on the portion of taxable income more than \$150,000 but not more than \$220,000, +
- 13.16% on taxable income over \$220,000
